Scott McLaughlin continues to establish himself as one of the most accomplished race car drivers in the world as he begins his eighth season with Team Penske and his fourth season competing in the NTT INDYCAR SERIES (NICS) in 2024. McLaughlin produced his best NICS championship finish in 2023 as he closed the season ranked third in the standings while driving the No. 3 Sonsio Chevrolet. The New Zealander has improved his championship finish in each of his three previous full-time NICS seasons after transitioning from the Australian Supercars Series.

In 2023, McLaughlin continued to build on his impressive resume as a Team Penske driver. The 30-year-old native of Christchurch, New Zealand won at Barber Motorsports Park in April for his 52nd victory since he joined Team Penske in 2017. The victory also placed him third on the team's all-time wins list. In addition to his win at Barber last season, McLaughlin powered to the pole position at World Wide Technology Raceway for his first career NTT P1 Award on an oval track. He and teammate Will Power enter the 2024 season tied for the most pole positions won in Team Penske history with 64. McLaughlin enjoyed a remarkably consistent season in 2023 as he recorded 14 top-10 finishes in 17 races. He also tied series champion Alex Palou for the most laps completed (2,258) over the course of the season.

One of the most successful racers in the history of Australian Supercars, McLaughlin jumped at the chance to move to the United States and compete full-time for Team Penske in the NTT INDYCAR SERIES in 2021. Racing the No. 3 Chevrolet, McLaughlin captured the NTT INDYCAR SERIES Rookie of the Year Award, as McLaughlin became the first Team Penske driver to win the honor since its inception in 1979.

McLaughlin resides in Charlotte, N.C. with his wife Karly. He has adopted the Carolina Panthers as his favorite NFL team and he is also a fan of the University of Wisconsin Badgers in college football. McLaughlin continues to root for New Zealand's All Blacks rugby team and he is an avid golfer.
